

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

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

A combined mentoring of all student of M.Sc. (Physics) including Sem II and IV was held in the HOD chamber of SoS in Physics and Astrophysics. Recently M.Sc II semester students received the result of M.Sc I sem two days back. The following problems were put forwarded by the majority of students

1) Though many students scored better marks in theory papers of M.Sc I sem, they scored poorly in the practical examinations.

Solution suggested :- They were advised to prepare viva-voce logically and were suggested to understand the theory validating the practicals. Mere performance of practicals without knowing the theory does not help in learning the subject.

2) In the new pattern of the theory examination, students asked for the choices in the questions.

Solution ; Students were advised that they must not expect choices in the long answer questions because it depends upon the paper setters choice due to the new system of examination as new directives have been not stated so far on this matter.

3) Many students find problems in answering the questions in English for they hail from Science colleges of Hindi medium

Solution for the abovementioned problem was put forward that they must practice answers in English by regular writing

on the paper again and again. thereby they may develop confidence in writing the exam in English medium.

4) All the teachers were advised to hold mentoring with their respective students at ^{least} twice in a semester. However, more of the mentoring sessions may improve the rapport between mentor (teacher) and mentee. So the students may ^{be} opened up ⁱⁿ conveying their problems - Academic as well as personal ones - to the mentor.
