Faculty Induction Program - (GURU-DAKSHATA)




Faculty Induction Program (GURU-DAKSHTA) of one month from 03.01.2023 to 04.02.2023 was conducted under the ambitious plan of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Education. The main objective of this program was to provide information related to technical and educational aspects of higher education to newly appointed assistant professors in colleges and universities. Forty-four assistant professors from two states namely Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh participated in this program. Out of which 03-03 each from Geography, Botany and Mathematics, 02-02 from History, Economics, Sociology, Political Science and Library Science each, 05-05 from English, Commerce and Chemistry, 01-01 from Physics, Hindi, Law and Geology. Among them, 26 participants were male and 12 participants were female. All the ten modules of the program had been carefully designed to incorporate the four coordinates (e-tutorials, e-content, web resources and self- assessment) prescribed by UGC. Eminent educationists and experts of various subjects (List enclosed) made the participants aware of the values of the society, new education system, research and new techniques through very good, effective and inspiring lectures and their doubts were resolved. Objective type online test of 10 marks at the end of each module as well as e-content development, brainstorming, Assignment, Seminar, Microteaching etc. from each module were conducted by the organizers and were successfully attended by the participants. The entire program was conducted on Google Meet platform every day in four sessions from 10.30 am to 5.30 pm.




Session II (12:15 to 13:45)


He told about the history of the university and other educational institutes in detail. Also, he discussed about the University Act, statues, Ordinances and its role and importance in governance.


Session III (14:15 to 15:45) & Session IV (16:00 to 17:30)



DAY 5, 09-01-2023


Session I (10:30 to 12:00) & Session II (12:15 to 13:45)



Session III (14:15 to 15:45) & Session IV (16:00 to 17:30)



DAY 7, 11-01-2023


Session I (10:30 to 12:00) & Session II (12:15 to 13:45)




Session III (14:15 to 15:45) & Session IV (10:00 to 17:30)
