**पुनर्मूल्यांकन आवेदन-पत्र संबंधी निर्देश**

1. परीक्षार्थी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु निर्धारित नियमों व निर्देशों का समुचित अध्ययन करने के उपरांत, नियमों के अधीन पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु आवेदन करें।

  - (C) जो परीक्षार्थी स्नातक (वार्षिक स्कीम के अंतर्गत) स्तर के परीक्षाओं में सभी विषयों में सम्मिलित हुए हैं, वे दो से अधिक प्रश्न पत्रों में पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु आवेदन नहीं कर सकेंगे तथा ऐसे परीक्षार्थियों को शेष विषयों के प्रत्येक विषय में कम से कम 33% अथवा उस कक्षा में न्यूनतम उत्तीर्ण अंक प्राप्त हुए रहना अनिवार्य है।
  - (D) जो परीक्षार्थी वार्षिक परीक्षा स्कीम के अंतर्गत स्नातकोत्तर परीक्षाओं के सभी प्रश्न-पत्रों में सम्मिलित हुए हैं वे दो से अधिक प्रश्न-पत्रों का पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु आवेदन नहीं कर सकेंगे तथा ऐसे परीक्षार्थियों के लिए शेष प्रश्न-पत्रों के प्रत्येक प्रश्न-पत्रों (वार्षिक स्कीम एवं विधि स्नातक परीक्षा) में कम से कम 36% अथवा उस कक्षा के न्यूनतम उत्तीर्ण अंक प्राप्त हुए रहना अनिवार्य है।
  - (E) संशोधित अध्यादेश 170 के अंतर्गत स्नातकोत्तर (सेमेस्टर प्रणाली) के कक्षाओं में कडिका 4 (5) के अनुसार पुनर्मूल्यांकन की सुविधा नहीं है। परीक्षार्थी केवल पुनर्गणना के लिए आवेदन कर सकते हैं।
  - (F) पुनर्मूल्यांकन आवेदन पत्र निम्न कारणों से निरस्त होंगे:
    1. जो छात्र तीन विषयों में अनुत्तीर्ण हैं और पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु फार्म जमा करते हैं, तो फार्म निरस्त माना जावेगा।
    2. जिन छात्रों को दो विषयों में अनुत्तीर्ण घोषित किया गया है ऐसे छात्र को दोनों विषयों के एक-एक प्रश्न-पत्र में पुनर्मूल्यांकन हेतु आवेदन करना होगा। यदि एक ही प्रश्न-पत्र में फार्म भरते हैं तो फार्म निरस्त माना जावेगा।
    3. जिन छात्रों को पूरक मिला है और उसमें सम्मिलित होने के बाद अनुत्तीर्ण हो जाते हैं ऐसे छात्र पुनर्मूल्यांकन की पात्रता नहीं रखेंगे।
9. परीक्षार्थियों को पुनर्मूल्यांकन परिणाम की जानकारी संबंधित महाविद्यालय के माध्यम से स्वतः लेनी होगी। पुनर्मूल्यांकन परिणाम विश्वविद्यालय के वेबसाइट पर भी देखे जा सकते हैं।
