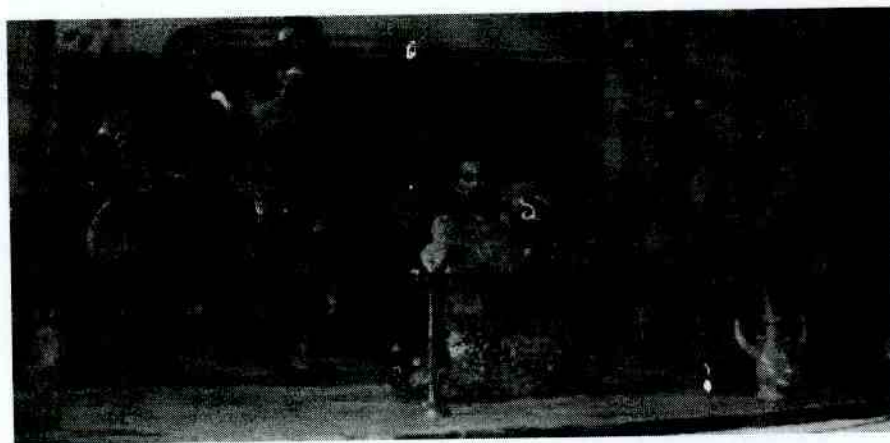

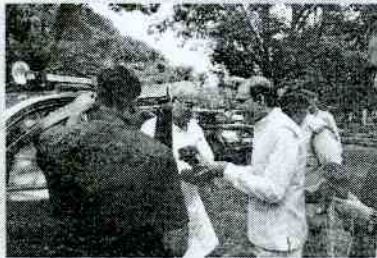

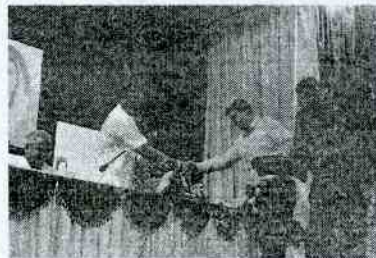

Date - 22nd June to 26th June 2020

great respect to today's Girl Child Day. Women need to come out in all spheres. The society need to create an environment, which helps in women and girls development.



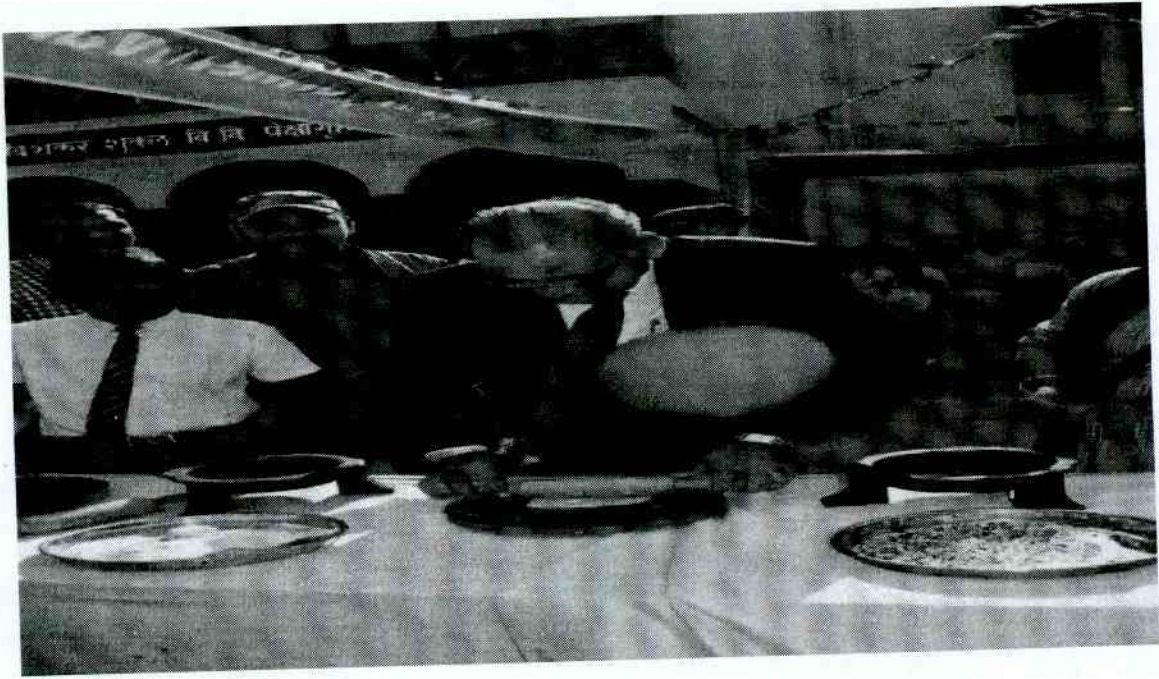

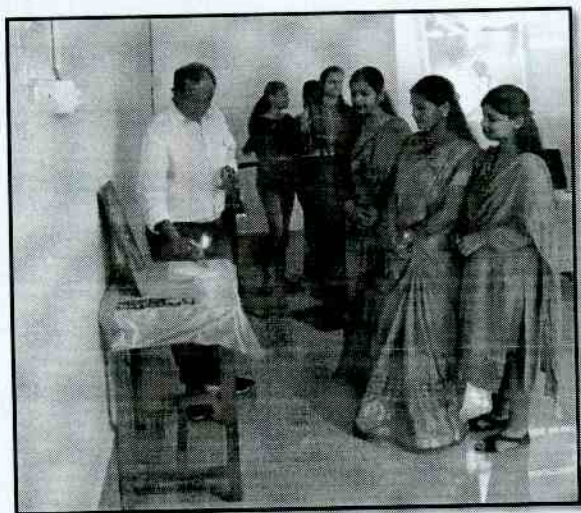
INDUCTION PROGRAMME

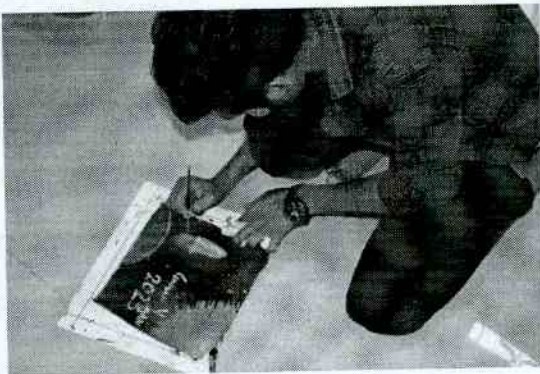
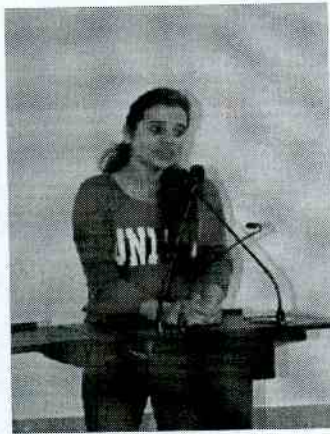

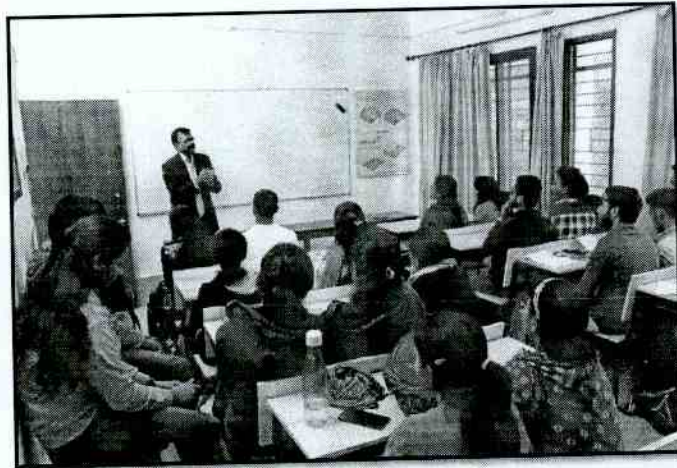

After his interaction with the students Astha Singh officially thanked his for visiting our department and also for interaction with the students.

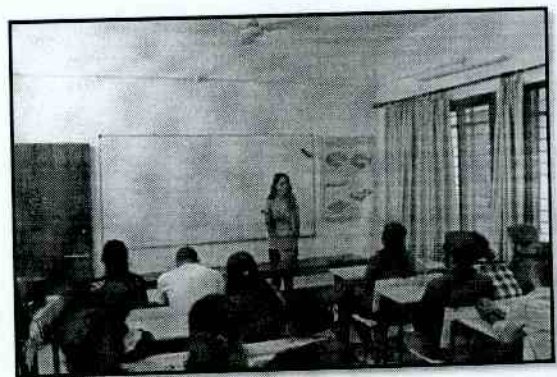
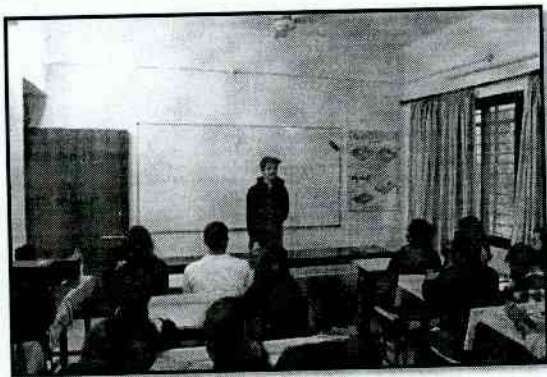


NATIONAL YOUTH DAY CELEBRATION (11.01.2020)

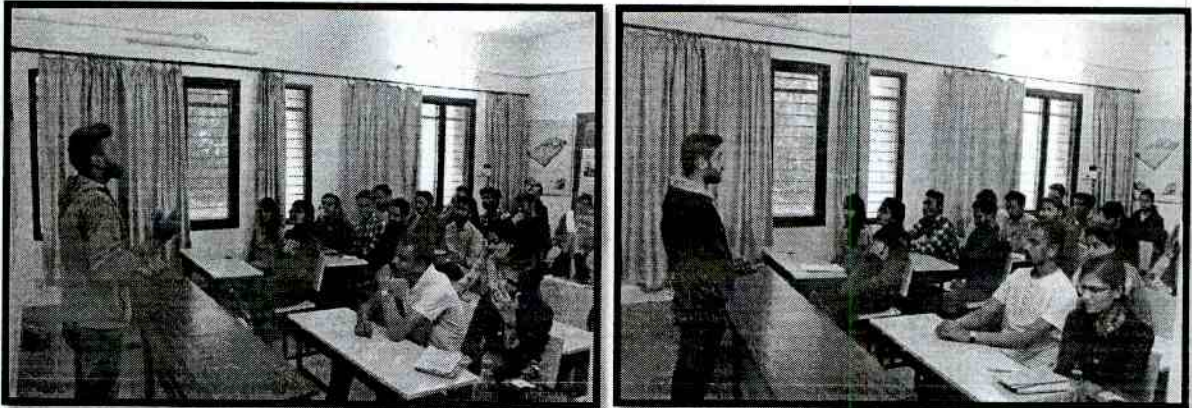
