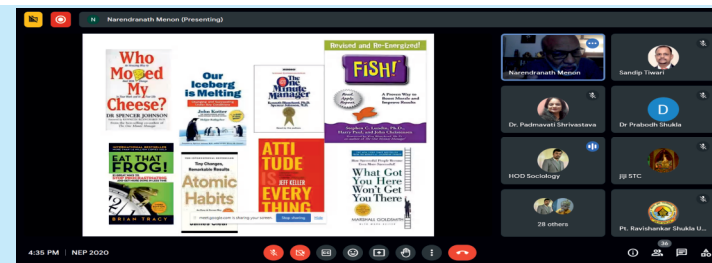


Online 8-Days Course: NEP-2020

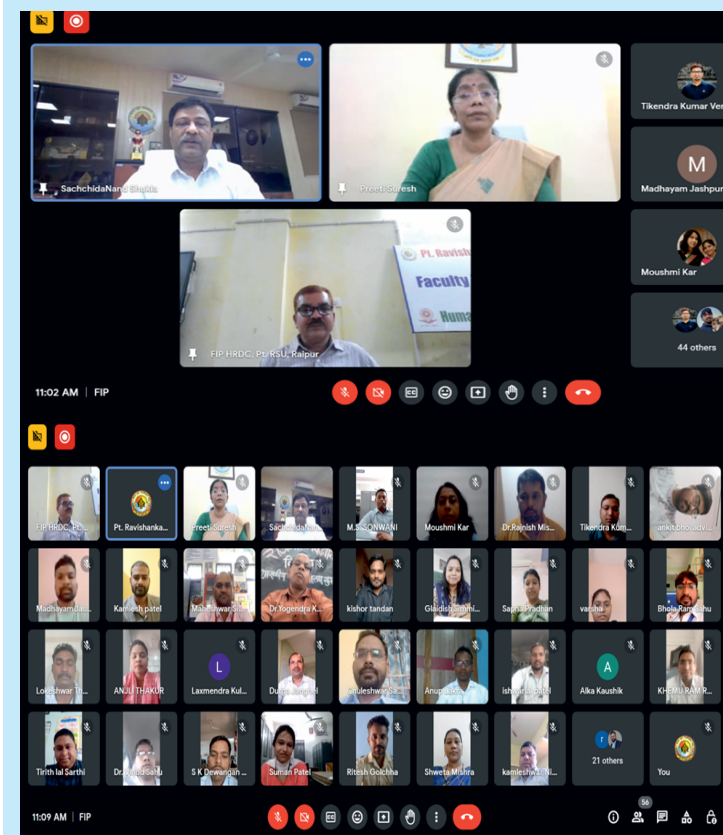

In this connection MMTTC Pt. R. S. U. has organized some programs as per the UGC norms\

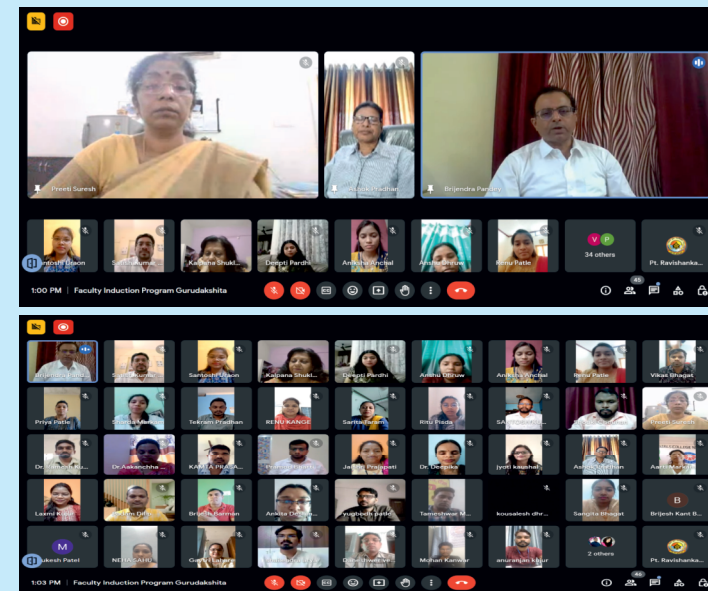

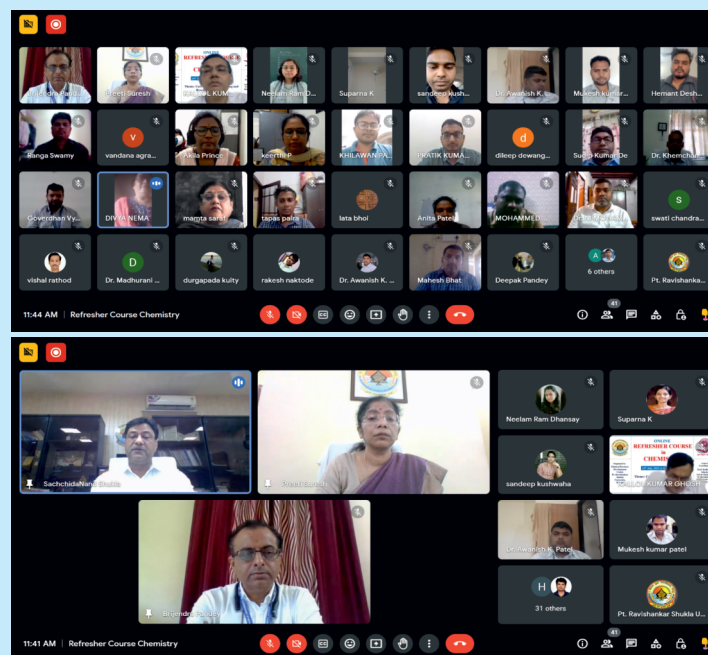

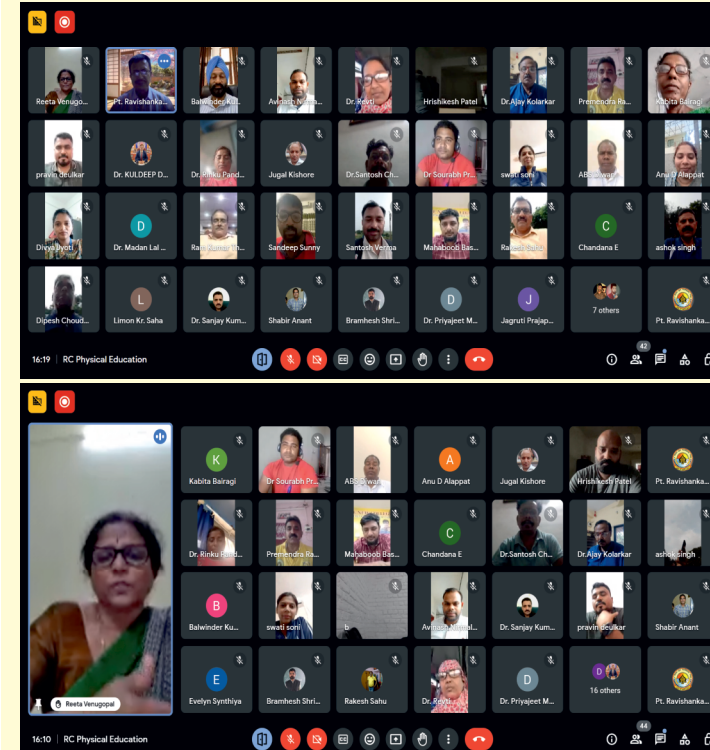
Refresher Courses:
