BACHELOR OF EDUCATION CORRESPONDENCE COURSE (ONE YEAR) B.ED. (C.C.).....ONE YEAR

1. A Teacher who had obtained a Bachelor's Degree of this University or a Degree recognised as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to Bachelor of Education Correspondence Course provided that he/she has worked as a Teacher in recognised school for not less than three years.
2. For admission to examination, a candidate shall apply to the Registrar of the University on a prescribed form through the Head, Department of Correspondence Courses and produce the following certificates -
 - (a) Certificate of having attended prescribed contact programmes of 10 days (to be organised in October/November) and 20 days (to be organised in May/June) duration organised by the department.
 - (b) Certificate of having taught 40 lessons (20 in each subject selected by the candidate for practice teaching) from the head of the Institution, where he/she has taught the lessons.
 - (c) Certificate from the coordinator of having completed all the assignments.

The University Examination for the Theory Papers shall be conducted in July and Final Teaching of School subjects in July/August.

3. The classification of division at the examination (Part-A and Part-B separately is given below ::-)

First Division	60% and above,
Second Division	50% to 59%
Third Division	40 % 49%

- (i) Candidate obtaining less than 40% marks will not be declared successful.
- (ii) In Theory Papers, minimum pass marks in each paper shall be 40 combined with External and Assignment taken together.
- (iii) Final Test of Practice Teaching 2 lessons and Craft Education Examination shall be conducted by a Board of two examiners appointed separately by the University.
- (iv) Assignments and Material relating to Part-I and Part-II of examinations will be collected before the commencement of the second contact programme and assessed by examiners appointed by the Head, Department of Correspondence Courses.
- (v) Theory and Practice on work experience (Craft-Education) will be conducted during Second Contact Programme and assessed in the same period by the examiners appointed by the University.

The scope of subjects will be indicted in the prospectus.

If a candidate fails in only one part of examination he or she may appear at a subsequent examination in that part only.
