- (vii) Semester Grade Point Average $(SGPA) = \Sigma(Ci \ x \ Gi) / \Sigma Ci$ where, Ci is the number of credits of the ith course and Gi is the grade point scored by the student in the ith course.
- (viii) Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) = Σ (Ci x Si) / Σ Ci where, Si is the SGPA of the ith semester and Ci is the total number of credits in that semester.
