RULES OF THE RAVISHANKER UNIVERSITY STUDENTS WELFARE FUND

Preliminary : The University shall maintain a students Welfare fund, designated as the Ravi-shanker University Students Welfare fund referred to as the fund.

Object of the fund : The object of the fund is to ensure that students Welfare Activities (Such as extra- curricular activities cultural, literary, social activities in general) and to promote equalization of opportunities to financially handicapped students, do not suffer unruly for want of funds.

Administration : The administration of the fund shall vest in Committee designated as the 'Students Welfare Fund Committee, Comprising :

Income of the Fund : Shall Comprise :-

- a) Subscription from students, formal and non-formal, at the rate of Rs. 1/- per head per year appearing in any of the exams. Conducted by the University, and.
- b) other contributions and grants.

Expenditure : Subsidies shall be granted as and when necessary from the fund for the undermentioned purposes -

- a) For promotion of students : Cultural, literary and social service activities at the University, Inter-University, State and Inter State Levels.
- b) For providing an annual contribution to the Ravishankar University Students Aid

Fund. This contribution shall not be less than 60 of the annual income of the fund or Rs. 25000/- which ever is less.

These subsidies and contributions shall be fixed and granted by the Ravishankar University Students Welfare fund committee provided that the Vice Chancellor may make a grant in an emergency.

Accounts & Audit : All income of the fund shall be credited to a saving bank account designated as the 'Ravishankar University Students Welfare Fund Account in a nationalized bank authorized by the Vice-Chancellor and all items of expenditure shall be made ordinarily by cheques issued on the Saving Bank Account. Operation of the Saving Bank Account shall be regulated in accordance with the operation procedures prescribed by the University for other Bank Accounts of the University.

The accounts of the Fund shall be subject to audit by the Statutory Auditors of the University. Internal Audit Checks may be imposed from time to time under orders of the Vice Chancellor.

Powers & Functions :

The Squad (Committee) will ensure proper conduct of the University examinations.

The members of the flying squad will have their authorisation letters with them.

The Squad (Committee) will have power enter directly the examination - Centre and to inspect each and every matter connected with the conduct of the examination, such as security of question papers & answer books, seating arrangements, appointment of invigilators and management of the examination during examination hours. They would,

however, take the Supdt. of the examination centre in to confidence and obtain their report on completion or during inspection.

If at the time of inspection, the members feel that unfair means materials are with the students, they can take a search of the person of the candidate(s) to recover the material.

The Leader of the Squad will send the report of the examination centre after its inspection and will send a detailed report after the completion of the examinations to the Registrar.

Emoluments to the Members :

The members of the committee will be entitled for T.A. & D.A. as per university rules in case university vehicles is provided the members will be paid D.A.

In addition to T.A. & D.A. remuneration at the rate of Rs. -----/- per centre inspected, with a maximum of Rs. -----/- per day will also be paid to the members of Flying Squad (Inspection committee)

The Registrar shall himself select the envelope (containing question paper) which is to be sent for the main examination.
2. Strict care shall be taken during the process of Moderation of question papers, and the safe custody of moderated question papers. As far as possible moderated question papers will not be kept in university office for long duration.
3. The Moderators shall bring their own seals for sealing of the envelopes containing moderated question papers. In no case shall the University office provide any seal or its substitute for sealing the said envelopes. The specimen seals of the Moderators given on the Certificates furnished by them, shall be compared with the seals on envelopes containing question papers Moderated by them, before they are sent to the press.
4. ✓ The Registrar select a press which is Registered as a Security press for printing of the question papers, and shall enter into a written contract with the press so as to ensure strict confidentiality regarding all matters concerning the the question papers including the fact that question papers are being printed at the press. 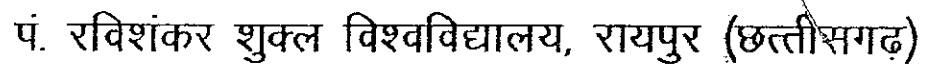
