About the Event

The Institute Innovation Council (IIC) of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, in collaboration with the Innovation & Incubation Centre and the School of Studies in Electronics and Photonics, organized a workshop on Business Model Canvas (BMC) on May 23, 2025, at the Computer Lab of the School of Studies in Electronics, PRSU, Raipur. The session was conducted by Mr. K. Anil Kumar, Innovation Ambassador, who is recognized for his expertise in guiding students and budding entrepreneurs in the field of innovation, startup ecosystem, and entrepreneurial practices.

The workshop was designed to provide participants with a clear and structured understanding of how to systematically build and refine business ideas using the Business Model Canvas framework, which has emerged as one of the most widely adopted tools in entrepreneurship. At the beginning of the session, he highlighted the importance of innovation and creative thinking in transforming raw ideas into sustainable business ventures. He explained that having an idea alone is not sufficient unless it is strategically structured, validated with the target market, and supported by strong planning.

A detailed explanation was provided on the nine building blocks of the Business Model Canvas—Customer Segments, Value Propositions, Channels, Customer Relationships, Revenue Streams, Key Resources, Key Activities, Key Partnerships, and Cost Structure. He elaborated on how these blocks are interconnected and collectively form the foundation of any successful enterprise. He emphasized that value creation and customer-centric approaches are at the heart of a robust business model. The session included practical illustrations and case studies of well-known startups and companies that have successfully utilized the BMC framework to scale their businesses.

The workshop was highly interactive, with students encouraged to actively participate by brainstorming their own innovative ideas and mapping them into the

BMC structure. This hands-on approach helped participants not only to understand the theoretical framework but also to visualize how their entrepreneurial concepts could be transformed into feasible business models. Through this exercise, students identified potential gaps, challenges, and opportunities within their ideas, which enhanced their ability to think strategically and analytically.

The session also addressed the significance of aligning business ideas with customer needs, the importance of partnerships and resources in scaling a venture, and the balance between revenue generation and cost management. By the end of the workshop, participants gained confidence in applying the BMC framework as a practical tool for developing, refining, and evaluating their entrepreneurial projects.
