

About the Event and Speaker

On the occasion of **World Intellectual Property Day 2025**, the Institution Innovation Council (IIC), Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, in association with the School of Studies in Law and the School of Studies in Electronics and Photonics, organized an expert session on April 26, 2025. The session was held at J.C. Bose Seminar Hall, School of Studies in Life Sciences, at 12:00 PM. The expert session was titled "The Changing Paradigms of Intellectual Property in the Age of Artificial Intelligence: From Justification to Enforcement" and was graced by Advocate Saurabh Tiwari, an expert in Technology Law, AI Jurisprudence, and Intellectual Property, as the Chief Speaker. The event was coordinated by Prof. Rajeev Choudhary, Head, S.O.S in Law, and supported by Prof. Kavita Thakur, President of IIC PRSU, and Dr. Shailendra Kumar Patel, Registrar, PRSU.

The program commenced with a traditional invocation to Goddess Saraswati and the university's anthem. Prof. Rajeev Choudhary welcomed the guests and introduced the keynote speaker.

In his address, Advocate Saurabh Tiwari highlighted the growing importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in fostering innovation and creativity, especially in the context of rapid advancements in Artificial Intelligence (AI). He discussed how AI is challenging traditional legal frameworks, citing the global case of DABUS, an AI system whose patent applications were controversially rejected in most countries but accepted in South Africa as an inventor.

He raised significant questions about the evolving definitions of authorship and inventor ship in the digital age, and explored how models like ChatGPT rely on publicly available data for training—raising ethical and legal concerns regarding copyright infringement.

The lecture also emphasized the critical role of legal reform, awareness, and proactive policy-making to ensure that IPR keeps pace with technological developments.

The event concluded with Vice-Chancellor Dr. Sachchidanand Shukla expressing appreciation for the thought-provoking session and felicitating Advocate Saurabh Tiwari for his valuable contribution. A vote of thanks was extended to all participants, marking the successful completion of a highly informative and engaging session.
