About the Speaker

Mrs. Kavita Dev, Director & Founder, Samarpann Natural Farms LLP Raipur (C.G.), in her lecture, underscored the imperative of motivating young minds toward entrepreneurship, describing it as a critical necessity of the present era. She asserted that entrepreneurship should no longer be viewed merely as a commercial pursuit; rather, it encompasses a broader responsibility toward addressing societal needs and ensuring collective welfare. In this context, she particularly emphasized the immense scope for innovation and growth within the agricultural sector. Highlighting the significance of farmers, Mrs. Dev described them not solely as "providers of food grains" but as fundamental contributors to the nourishment, health, and sustainability of society. She noted that entrepreneurial initiatives in agriculture can play a pivotal role in realizing the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat (Self-Reliant India) while also advancing the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). According to her, agriculture-based entrepreneurship adopted by the youth has the potential to ensure the supply of safe, nutritious, and high-quality food, alongside fostering employment generation and innovation.

In her address, Mrs. Dev also elaborated on the nutritional and entrepreneurial importance of millets (*Shree Anna*), categorizing them into two groups:

- 1. Major Millets: Jowar, Bajra, Ragi
- 2. Minor Millets: Kodo, Kutki, Kangni, Sanwa, Chena

She further highlighted the specific health benefits of minor millets:

- Kodo millet contributes to intestinal health due to its high fiber content.
- Little millet (Kutki) supports the reproductive system.
- Foxtail millet (Kangni) is beneficial for neuronal functioning and brain health.

Concluding her lecture, Mrs. Dev emphasized that the regular incorporation of these nutrient-dense grains into daily diets not only enhances human health but also unlocks promising opportunities for agricultural entrepreneurship. Such integration of nutrition and innovation, she observed, would significantly contribute to societal well-being, economic self-reliance, and sustainable development.
