




SOS IN PSYCHOLOGY STUDENTS FEEDBACK SCORE (FACULTY SCORE)














SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES BY MA IN RURAL DEVELOPMENT & PG DIPLOMA





OVERALL SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES




SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES RESPONSE PERCENT BY MA STUDENTS


