The inaugural program of the workshop began at 11:00 AM, on 23rd December 2023, with the gracious presence of Prof. S.N. Shukla, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur as the Chief Guest, Resource Persons, Prof. A.K. Gupta, Former Professor & Head, School of Studies in Life Science, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, Prof. Kallol K Ghosh, School of Studies in Chemistry & Director, Center for Basic Sciences, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, Prof. Preeti K Suresh, University Institute of Pharmacy & Director, MMTTC, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, and Prof. Arti Parganiha, Director, Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur.

The function began with the Kulgeet and the welcome of the guests. A welcome address was delivered by Prof. Arti Parganiha. 
