REVISED ORDINANCE NO. – 91

(Under Section 38)

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA)

- 01. The Degree shall be known as Bachelor of Business Administration.
- O2. The duration of this course is extended over Three academic section. This three years full time course has been broken into three parts:
 - Part I Known as BBA Part-I

Examination at the End of First Year

Part II - Known as BBA Part-II

Examination at the End of Second Year

Part III - Known as BBA Part-III

Examination at the End of Third Year

- O3. The minimum qualifications for admission to the BBA course shall be Higher-Secondary Education (10+2) of C.G. Board of Secondary Education, Raipur or any other examination recognized equivalent thereto by the University for the Purpose.
- 04. The admission to BBA course of study under University Affiliated Colleges shall be made on merit basis. (Merit will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in theory papers of 10+2 examination)
- 05. English shall be the medium of instruction and examination for the course of study.
- 06. The Initial intake capacity for the affiliated Colleges shall be 40 students.
- 07. The student admitted to BBA course shall not be permitted to appear at any other examination.
- 08. The BBA Course shall consist of:
 - a. Such Courses / papers;
 - b. Project work.

As may be prescribed by Board of Studies [Management], Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur from time to time.

- 09. A student shall be eligible to appear in the examination if he/she has attended at least 75 percent of the classes.
- 10. Student must appear in internal test for each theory paper which will comprise of 10% of Aggregate marks. There will be no supplementary of examination of internal test. However once a student awarded internal marks, it will be carried forward in the subsequent examinations (Supplementary) appeared by the student.

- 11. A candidate to be declared pass in any part of BBA examination shall be required to obtain at least 45% marks in each paper (both in internal and external examination taken to together).
- 12. A candidate failing in not more than two papers will be allowed to appear in supplementary examination.
- 13. A candidate who has been declared eligible for supplementary examination may appear as a supplementary examination candidate in two examinations, immediately following the examinations in which he was declared to be so eligible and there after he shall be required to appear in all the papers at the next examination.
- 14. A candidate declared pass at the BBA Part-I examination shall be eligible to promoted to the BBA Part-II and shall be eligible for appearing in the BBA Part-II examination.
- 15. A candidate declared pass at the BBA Part-II examination shall be eligible to be promoted to the BBA-III and shall be eligible for appearing in the BBA Part-III examination.
- 16. A candidate who secures 60 percent or more marks in total aggregate of Part-I, Part-II and Part-III examination shall be awarded First Division. A candidate who secures less than 60 percent but 45 percent marks or more in the total aggregate of marks shall be awarded Second Division.
- 17. There shall be no Third Division.
- 18. A candidate not permitted to take up the BBA Part-I examination due to shortage of attendance, shall be required to apply for admission afresh in the next Academic session.
- 19. The provision for revaluation in BBA course shall be same as provided in the RSU ordinance.
- 20. For the rules not defined here, the rules of general ordinance of the RSU shall apply here & in case of any conflict Board of Studies shall be empowered to take the decision accordingly.
